## How to configure Photoshop to work with action

- **Make sure you are using the English version of Photoshop.**

- **Use the RGB Mode and 8 Bits color.**

To check these settings, go to Image->Mode and check the “RGB color” and “8 Bits/Channel”.

- **Make sure that the option “Add ‘copy’ to Copied Layers and Groups” and “Use Default Masks on Fill Layers” is turned on.**

On the “LAYERS” panel, click on the menu icon, go to “Panel Options...”

and check that the “Add ‘copy’ to Copied Layers and Groups” is turned on. “Use Default Masks on Fill Layers” is turned on.

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## Image resolution

- **For the best results, it is recommended to use photos in the range of 800px - 3000px.**

In order to get correct shapes scale

- **Use a photo with 72dpi.**

Go to Image->Image Size and change resolution to 72. Resample checkbox - **OFF**.

- **In order to get correct design scale**

Play “2000 px +” action for 2000-3000 px photos.

Play “800 px +” action for 800-2000 px photos.

- **Prepare photo for “2000 px +” action**

Go to Image->Image Size and change width or height to 2000 px. Resample checkbox - **ON**.

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
## How to install the action

1. Double click on the "Contemporary graphic poster Action.atn" file to load it inside Photoshop.
  2. Double click on the "Contemporary Poster Patterns.pat" file to load it.
  3. Drag and drop the "Wave Custom Shape.csh" file onto Photoshop to load it.
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## How to use the action

1. Open your image and be sure it has right resolution and size; (Image - Image Size)
2. Be sure your photo layer is set as the “Background” locked layer; (Layer - New - Background from Layer)
3. Create a new layer and name it "AREA" (uppercase letters)
4. Paint on the layer the area that you need to focus. Use Pen Tool (P) in “shape” mode to make perfect area masks.
5. Click play on action selected in action panel. (Window - Actions)
6. After the action is finished, adjust the layer's location, size, and colors if needed.
